ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

What has God been speaking to you lately? Is there a verse or passage that has been especially helpful during this season? Please share with your group.

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in these verses or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What is Paul referring to in verse 18 when he says "the glory that is to be revealed to us"?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) What situations or circumstances cause you to feel hopeless?
- 4) How do these verses and the promise of future glory give you hope in the face of the things that you will/are suffering in this life?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

- 5) In light of this passage, how are you going to apply these truths to your life this week? Is there a promise that God wants you to hold on to or a truth that you need to embrace? Ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk in the hope that is yours as a child of the King.
