ICEBREAKER QUESTION: Have you ever left your home and worried that you forgot something important? If so, what was it and did you go back for it?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) How does this passage challenge common misconceptions about worry and provide a rational basis for trusting in God's provision?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) How does this passage illustrate the impact that worry can have on our relationship with God?
- 4) Why does nurturing a deeper emotional trust in God's faithfulness help alleviate our feelings of worry? What other remedies to worry resonate with you?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) What practical strategy or mindset shift can help you let go of future uncertainties and trust in God's guidance for each day?

Prayer Application: Pray for everyone in our church to be set free from worry or anxiety and that we would trust in God!
