ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is something you have recently built?

HEAD

- 2) What does this passage teach us about our view of Scripture and the church?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) What Bible verses have encouraged you in your faith and why?
- 4) Who has been a strong Christian influence in your life and how were they impactful in your faith?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) With the strength that God has given you, who can you build up with biblical encouragement this week?

Prayer Application: Pray for the people God has put on your heart to build up in Him. Pray that God would grant you maturity and strength with which to do so.
