2. All mentors are to open and close every mentoring session with prayer and are to refer to an open Bible during the mentoring session.
3. Privacy should always be mutually respected between each other.
4. Certain communications made by a counselee, may be required under applicable California law to be reported to the appropriate legal authorities. In these instances the counselor and the Biblical Counseling Ministry will make every effort to work with the counselee to address these issues.
5. Woman to woman mentoring only.
6. By accepting by the Mentoring Ministry, the mentoree agrees to the following:
 - A. To commit themselves to the purpose of the mentoring.
 - B. To be open and honest during the mentor sessions.
 - C. To be diligent in the completion of all homework and/or exercises assigned.
 - D. To commit to a regular schedule of worship, Bible study, and prayer agreed upon with the mentor.
7. The failure to adhere to the above commitments may result in the mentor relationship being terminated.
