ICEBREAKER QUESTION: question?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What were the three movements or main points the prophet Micah presented in Micah 6, and how do they connect to the overall message of God reminding His people of their identity?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) How does Micah contrast the acts of sacrifice with the deeper requirements of justice, kindness, and humility before God? (Micah 6:6-8)
- 4) How has a biblical figure or someone in your life helped you retrain your mind to live within your Christian identity?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) What memory (or memories) of God's faithfulness can you consider this week that will encourage you in the struggles you currently face? Write it down and put it somewhere you'll see it this week!
